[God's Acre Archerfield](#) 1859 Cemetery between the main gates of Archerfield Aerodrome. Early pioneers of Brisbane. Thomas Grenier bought his first block of ground in 1843 on the corner of Melbourne St and Grey St South Brisbane. The first recorded purpose built racecourse in Moreton bay was built on this 640 acre property which is now an aerodrome. Thomas bought the land in 1855 and racing continued til shortly before his death in 1877 and a new racecourse was built behind Samuel Manning's Rose and Crown Hotel on Beaudesert Rd.
